




- FY23 year-end data analysis

 - Back-end upgrades







Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)


- DOE Requirement
- Driven by EO 14128, Improving the Nations Cybersecurity
- Needed to advance toward Zero Trust Architecture (ZTA)
- Strengthens application security





Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) (Cont'd)

- FIMS/CAIS will support two methods of MFA
- Code generated from the Google or Microsoft Authenticator apps
- To support those sites that don't allow phones, a code will be emailed to the user





FIMS/CAIS Single Sign-on (SSO)



- Benefits users of both application
- Will simplify password management
- Will streamline navigation between the two applications









- MFA will be implemented first: End of 2023
- Will pilot at a few sites for testing
- SSO will be implemented in 2024 (Date TBD)

- Currently scheduled for February 15, 2024
 - Updates for all Assembly and Master Format line items
 - Updated Geographic Adjusters, Labor/Crew and Rental Equipment data
 - Escalation of all Engineered costs
 - Automatic recalculation of all CAIS generated costs
 - Automatic recalculation of all Estimating Module costs including RPV estimates
 - Recalculation of all FIMS generated RPV estimates
 - Addition of new RPV models
 - Updated RPV Model costs
