There is also a huge need to have a filter drop down selection that allows us to select for Asset level reports DM flag "Y", DM flag "N", RN flag "Y", RN flag "N", or ALL). For Ad-Hoc IU level reports we have an existing filter for DM flag "Y", DM flag "N" but we have a big need to add to this drop down RN flag "Y", RN flag "N", or "ALL".				
Justification:	In the world of data management minimizing keystrokes is critical to good time management. Many people at Pantex ask me for specific CAIS data with specific scopes of work. Some want only DM IUs, some involve RN IUs, while others want to see everything for their facilities. In most cases my Program Managers are requesting CAIS DM data for specific assets. Right now in order to provide my customers the information they want and need I use the current CAIS Ad-Hoc tool by pulling into one Excel spreadsheet two different Ad-Hoc reports (one for DM and one for Non-DM) all CAIS IUs by copying and pasting. I then have to filter and remove the assets and data they don't need/want. The proposed changes above will greatly reduce my time and effort of getting clean reports to my customers in the way they want to view the data. Thank you for your consideration.
