CCB Remarks:	10/26/2016 – CCB Not Recommended. There is already a filter in place for the Program Office. As for the other two fields, the Group field is only used by 4 of the 51 CAIS Sites. The Assigned Contractor is actually a FIMS data element and is optional. The use of Assigned Contractor in FIMS is basically used by just a few Sites.  The CCB feels that this request does not provide any increased capability for the greater CAIS user community. One of the more important roles of the CCB is to look for opportunities for CAIS improvements that benefit most if not all Sites and not just a select few. Microsoft Excel has filter capabilities that can be activated with a click of a button and would serve well for filtering on the Group and Assigned Contractor data elements. The purpose and design of the CAIS ad-hoc reporting tool is to make it simple for any level user to export CAIS data into Excel. Once in Excel, you can use a variety of tools to further sort, filter, add totals and format the output.
