Proposed Change:	Add a new "Location" data element on the Estimate Detail window for each line item included in the estimate. This would apply to both line item and custom model estimates. This new "Location" field would be free form text with a maximum length of 25 characters. Also ensure the Estimate Detail window provides sort capability on the new "Location" data element.				
Justification:	This gives the estimator the ability to quickly identify where, within the project, a specific task or item is located, or tasks and items are grouped. An example, recently we assembled an estimate to repaint the exterior of the Federal Building. Knowing our budget may not allow for a complete painting project, I created locations within the estimate spread sheet. These locations gave me the ability to quickly revise the estimate by pulling out specific locations , specific task or specific grouped tasks within a location, so that the revised estimate then fell within our allotted budget. Not all estimates need Locations, thus an option feature for the estimator. I have attached the FB Exterior Painting Estimate Spread sheet as an example.
