Subject: Condition Assessment Information System (CAIS) Version 3.43 Release



Today, Friday, January 14, 2022, version 3.43 of the Condition Assessment Information System (CAIS) was released. This release addresses the following enhancements.

CAIS Mobile IU

- The **IU Number** picklist has been changed to a display only field. It continues to default to ‘New IU’ upon entering the Mobile IU window to allow the creation of a Staged IU once a **Property ID** is selected.

A new ‘Existing IUs’ button has been added to the right of the **IU Number** data field. Click the



button to display a list of existing IUs as well as the option of ‘New IU’. Clicking the button will open a popup window that will display the following:

- **Viewed** – check box that displays a check mark to show that an IU record has been viewed
 - **IU Number** – click this link to open any existing IU or click ‘New IU’ to create a Staged IU
 - **Location Description** – displays the existing IU location of the inspection unit (if populated)
 - **Description** – displays the existing IU description of the inspection unit (if populated)
- **Deferred Maintenance** indicator has been added to the existing Repair Needs and Modernization indicators. Repair Needs will continue to be the default selection for New IUs.
 - **Equipment Id** has been added. This field is optional.
 - For existing IUs, the **Quantity** data field has been enabled to allow for updates. When the Quantity is updated, the existing IU is recosted.
