Subject: Condition Assessment Information System (CAIS) Version 3.48 Release

Today, Wednesday, December 13, 2023, version 3.48 of the Condition Assessment Information System (CAIS) was released. This release addresses the following enhancements.

Multi-Factor Authentication

Multi-Factor Authentication for the Condition Assessment Information System (CAIS) has been released to provide additional application security. The CAIS application will be accessed in the same way as before, with one exception. Following initial login, the user will be given an option of authenticating through an Authenticator App or Email Verification.

Some sites were chosen to participate in the testing of Multi-Factor Authentication through the CAIS test website. Users who utilized the Authenticator option will not have to go through the setup process again. The authenticator application currently in place will work with the production CAIS website. Users will be sent instructions on how to appropriately navigate this new process.

Establishment of the Science Field Office

The former Chicago and Oak Ridge offices have now been consolidated into the new Science Field Office. No action is needed by any user belonging to the Chicago or Oak Ridge offices. As a result of this consolidation, the previous Oak Ridge office Sites now have a new Site Number. The new site numbers are listed below. The Sites that were a part of the previous Chicago office will continue to have the same Site Numbers.
