Today, Thursday, June 27, 2024, version 3.52 of the Condition Assessment Information System (CAIS) was released. This release addresses the following enhancements.

## FIMS/CAIS Single Sign-on

- We have now implemented single sign-on for FIMS/CAIS. This offers the convenience of only having one set of login credentials to access both the FIMS and CAIS applications. The URL to access both applications is <a href="https://fims.doe.gov/FIMS">https://fims.doe.gov/FIMS</a>. This is the current FIMS login URL. The previous URL used for CAIS is no longer valid.
- Your will need to use your FIMS login credentials in order to access CAIS. Once you log into FIMS, you will now see a link to CAIS on the FIMS home page as well as a CAIS menu option on the left. Your CAIS login credentials are no longer needed as well as a CAIS authenticator app if you were using one. From CAIS, you can easily get back to FIMS by clicking on the FIMS link on the CAIS home page or click 'FIMS' from the menu at the top.
- If you do not have an active FIMS account, please reach out to the FIMS/CAIS help desk so that we can get you setup with one.
- Moving forward, if you have any password issues, you will need to contact your FIMS Administrator instead of your CAIS Administrator. The CAIS Administrator no longer has password responsibilities. The CAIS Administrator still has responsibility for managing users' security level within CAIS.
