	Provider of Choice Authority – Delegation from GSA (PC) – The Administrator of General Services has issued a standing delegation of authority (under a program formerly known as "Can't Beat GSA Leasing", now referred to as "Provider of Choice") to the head of all Federal agencies to accomplish all functions relating to leasing of general purpose space for terms of up to 20 years and below prospectus level requirements, regardless of geographic location. General purpose space is defined as office and related space, as well a warehouse space.

	General Purpose (PC) – A standing delegation of authority from the Administrator of General Services Administration to the heads of all Federal agencies, under a program called "Provider of Choice" (formerly known as "Can't Beat GSA Leasing), to accomplish all functions relating to leasing of general purpose space including office, laboratory, and warehouse space. General Purpose delegation is limited to no more than 19,999 rentable square feet of space for terms of up to 20 years and below prospectus level requirements, regardless of geographic location. See Federal Management Regulation (FMR) Part 102-72.30. FMR Bulletin 2008-B1 – Revised Implementation Requirements of the Delegation of Lease Acquisition Authority established new requirements for agencies using the General Purpose lease delegation authorization provided by GSA in 1996. The bulletin reemphasizes and modifies certain procedures associated with the use of General Purpose, Categorical, and Special Purpose leasing authorities.
