Status = Non-operating – Historical For the Manhattan Project National Historic Park, NNSA recommends: Create a new Historic Designation for the Manhattan Project National Historic Park – say MPNHP (or possibly something shorter). While most historic structures have been shutdown, they won't be dispositioned; they aren't operating with a current "DOE" mission. NNSA believes a new historical category needs to be created for Manhattan Project National Historic Park.
