Proposed Change:	<p>1.) When viewing the Upload Status Log after any Upload, I propose to remove all records where the comment is "Note: RPV has been recalculated." These type of comments are not Rejected errors and these types of records do not display the PROP ID.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">   </p> <p>2.) In addition to the proposed change, under the Print button, all records should be printed from the Upload Status Log not only the first page (currently the max of 33 records is being printed).</p>				
Justification:	<p>1. The Upload Status Log should be showing only the actual rejected records. For Example: Gross Sqft cannot be less than Net Sqft or Goal Subject – Facilities (GSF) + Non-Energy Consuming Facilities (GSF) + Excluded Facilities (GSF) must be equal to Gross Sqft. If a Site has 900 records and you process an Upload, your Upload Status Log will list 900 records. 895 could be Note: RPV has been recalculated and 5 could be one or both of the examples listed above.</p> <p>2. Need to be able to print the entire Upload Status Long to view all records and also to be able to use the file as a working document.</p>				
FAC Remarks:	<p>09/28/2016 – FAC Not Recommended. The FAC feels the vast majority of the user community find the informational message related to the RPV being recalculated useful. Since the RPV is a critical data field and sites are sensitive to changes in the RPV, it is helpful to have that message appear.</p> <p>Regarding item 2, that appears to be a bug in the software. All records should print and the FIMS support team will investigate further on this item.</p>
