The value should be displayed but not updatable for Excessed assets.</p>				
Justification:	<p>The change will allow a Site to avoid needing to look up and manually enter overall asset condition for each excess asset whenever analyzing and preparing overall asset condition reports. The change will save some time and eliminate potential errors when reporting overall asset condition.</p>

FAC Remarks:	<p>06/26/2019 – FAC Not Recommended. The FAC suggested the historical ad-hoc query tool can be used to pull this information for those assets in Shutdown status. This could lead to misinterpretation of the data.</p>
