Proposed Change:	<p>The DOE Infrastructure Executive Committee (IEC) consists of the senior leaders responsible for managing infrastructure across each of the six DOE programs that manage national laboratories. These programs include the Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy (EERE), Environmental Management (EM), Fossil Energy (FE), National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA), Nuclear Energy (NE), and the Office of Science (SC).</p> <p>In a coordinated effort among all of its members, the IEC as a whole reviewed all of the FIMS data elements to identify areas for streamlining infrastructure data tracking and reporting. As a result of this effort the IEC recommends deleting the following seven FIMS data elements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Conventional Facility Indicator • Mission Unique Facility Description • Renewal Rent Next • Site Zip • Space Alternatively Used • Total Space Type Usable SF • Total Space Type Utilized SF 				
Justification:	<p>None of these data elements proposed for deletion are required by the Federal Real Property Profile, the DOE 430.1C order, or any other directive or statute. None of these data elements are included in the FIMS validation process. Furthermore, the Department as a whole does not use these data elements in any of its internal or external reports. This indicates that these data elements are not necessary to support any Departmental infrastructure decision-making or reporting requirements. Eliminating these elements will help streamline the FIMS data process and allow FIMS administrators and facility managers to better focus on those providing quality FIMS data for those elements required by statute and/or those elements that help support infrastructure decision-making.</p>
