Proposed Change:	Modify requirement to enter Activity Type					
Justification:	Activity Type data field was added to FIMS in 2018. The current process to enter data is to use AAIM info to populate. However, this is not foolproof way to capture the info as many assets are not entered in AAIM. So, proposing that each site be required to enter the Activity Type for any and all assets added to FIMS regardless of Usage category or ownership. The requirement would be for newly added assets beginning with the implementation of this change request. Sites would not be required to populate for previously entered assets. AAIM data would no longer be used. "Activity Type" field is defined as follows:

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FAC Remarks:	08/28/2019-FAC Recommendations are listed below.	
	1. The FAC recommended this data element be defined as <u>optional</u> . It is recommended that the Office of Science issue guidance to their SC sites requiring them to populate this data element if they wish. The other Sites associated with other Program Offices did not see any value in this data element and emphasized the cost associated with collecting this data.	
	2. The AAIM module will continue to collect Activity Type and be transferred to FIMS for new assets. The site, at their discretion, may update the value at any time.	
	3. The FAC also suggested that feedback be provided to John Yates regarding the options for Activity Type. It is common for Sites to find real property assets on Site that must be entered into FIMS and the current options do not provide an appropriate selection given the funding source for these assets is unknown. One suggestion was to add an option labelled 'Existing Asset – Unknown'. It was also discussed that sometimes Sites have purchases or indirect projects on Site and no legitimate option exists for these circumstances either. One suggestion was to possibly expand the definition of 'Other' for these situations.
