SUBJECT: Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) Version 2.6 Release

Today, Wednesday, January 16, 2013, version 2.6 of the Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) was released. The URL to access the FIMS application is <u>https://fimsweb.doe.gov</u>. This release addresses the following enhancements which will automatically be available when you log into FIMS from your browser.

- The following FIMS standard reports have been modified to align with the FY13 data validation guidance.
 - Standard report #69 (Random Asset Generator)
 - Standard report #69a (DOE Leased Assets)
 - Standard report #70b (FRPC Element Report)
- A new FIMS standard report #69b (Land Validation) has been developed. This report will be used to select DOE Owned, DOE Ingrant DOE Leased and Withdrawn from Public Domain land records from FIMS for the purpose of conducting FY13 data validations.
- Version 4.0 of the FIMS data validation forms has been released. The new forms can be found on the FIMS informational website (<u>http://fimsinfo.doe.gov</u>) on the data validation page. The new version of these forms is aligned with the FY13 FIMS data validation guidance that was signed out by Paul Bosco, Director, Office of Acquisition and Project Management on September 17, 2012. In addition, there is a new validation form to be used to validate DOE Owned, DOE Leased, and Withdrawn from Public Domain land records. Reference the FIMS data validation guidance for information on the criteria for qualifying land records for validation.
- Standard report #200 (Site Infrastructure Data Snapshot) has been modified to align with the latest Ten-Year Site Plan (TYSP) guidance. The report will now include data from the FY12 year-end snapshot.
- The FIMS User's and Reporting Guides have been updated to reflect these enhancements. These documents can be obtained from the FIMS informational website (<u>http://fimsinfo.doe.gov/documentation.htm</u>).
