Subject: Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) Version 3.16 Release

Today, Thursday, January 9, 2020, version 3.16 of the Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) was released. This release addresses the enhancements listed below.

RPV Window (Buildings and Trailers)

- The processing for generating FIMS building and trailer **RPV** values has been modified. You now have the options to use the following parameters when calculating a FIMS generated **RPV** value.
 - **RPV Geographic Adjuster** (Display only, defaults to a value based on **Location Zip Code**)
 - **Size** (Display only, defaults to FIMS value)
 - **No of Floors** (Display only, defaults to FIMS value – For trailers it will always be 1)
 - **RPV Factor**
 - **Perimeter** (New)
 - **Floor Height** (New)
 - **Wall/Framing Type** (New)
 - **Basement** (New)
- This window will identify the **RPV** source as FIMS, CAIS or Other. An **RPV** source of 'CAIS' indicates the estimate originated from the CAIS Cost Estimating Module. Any modifications to the **RPV** value, will need to be made in CAIS. An 'Other' source represents **RPV** values that are site calculated values entered into FIMS.
- All FIMS generated **RPV** building and trailer values were recalculated using the parameters listed in the first bullet item.

New Asset Window (Buildings and Trailers)

- **No of Floors** and **Location Zip Code** have been added to the Detail section of this window. For trailers, **No of Floors** will default to one.

New Site Window

- **Site Geographic Adjuster** has been removed from this window and from FIMS. This data element was previously used in the **RPV** calculation but it no longer needed as **Location Zip Code** is now used as the basis for the **RPV Geographic Adjuster**.

RPV Data Element Requirement Change

- **RPV** is now required for the following additional **Ownerships**.
 - DOE License
 - Federal Permit
 - Non-Federal Permit
 - Contractor Owned
 - Contractor License
 - Grant Recipient Owned

Change Request 19-05 (Removal of Total No of Other Personnel)

- **Total No of Other Personnel** has been removed from the Utilization window and from FIMS. Previous values in the **Total No of Other Personnel** have been added to the **Total No of Contractor Personnel**.
- **Total No of Other Personnel** has been removed from the ad-hoc query tool.
- Reference the revised definitions for **Total No of Federal Employees** and **Total No of Contractor Employees** in Appendix A, Data Element Dictionary, of the FIMS User's Guide.

Data Validation Report Updates

- The following data validation standard reports and forms have been modified to align with the FY20 data validation guidance from the Office of Asset Management (MA-50).
 - 016 (DOE Owned Data Validation Reporting Form)
 - 017 (DOE Leased, Contractor Leased and GSA Data Validation Reporting Form)
 - 018 (DOE Land Data Validation Reporting Form)
 - 019 (DOE Disposition Data Validation Reporting Form)
 - 020 (DOE Owned Data Validation Outlier Report)

Data Validation Website Content

- The Source Documentation Worksheet, sample Inbrief/Outbrief template and sample Corrective Action Plan have been updated based on the latest FY20 data validation guidance from the Office of Asset Management (MA-50).

Core Capability Updates

- A new Core Capability called 'Crude Oil Stock and Store' has been added to FIMS for the Strategic Petroleum Reserve (SPR). The **Core Capability 1** field for all SPR assets has been converted to this new Core Capability. **Core Capabilities 2-5** for the SPR have been blanked out.
- **Core Capability 1-5** fields for all NNSA assets have been removed. **Core Capability 1** will be repopulated with data provided by NNSA Headquarters. All of the current NNSA Core Capability codes are no longer valid and have been removed from FIMS. Questions related to this should be directed to your Headquarters NNSA point of contact.

- Anomaly Report 17 has now been split up into the following Anomaly Reports:
 - Anomaly #17 – FRPP RPV Compare
 - Anomaly #20 – FRPP Repair Needs Compare
