Today, Wednesday, January 4, 2023, version 3.31 of the Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) was released. This release addresses the enhancements listed below.

FY23 Data Validation Updates

- The following data elements have been removed from the DOE Owned Data Validation Reporting form.
 - Roads – Public Access Miles
 - Roads – Public Access Lane Miles
- The Bridge Inspection sheet has been removed from the DOE Owned Data Validation Reporting form.
- The following verifications have been removed from the DOE Owned Data Validation Reporting form Scorecard.
 - Bridge Safety Inspection
 - Bridge & Culvert
 - Public Access Roads
 - In-Situ
- The Sustainability data element has been added to the DOE Owned Data Validation Reporting form and the DOE Leased, Contractor Leased, and GSA Data Validation Reporting form.
- A new standard report (024) has been developed that will generate the DOE Bridge Data Validation Reporting form. The assets included in this validation will be controlled and publicly accessible train and vehicular bridges with a Status of Operating, Standby and Outgranted. This validation reporting form will include the following data elements that are associated with DOE Order 437.1.
 - Routine Inspection Date
 - Routine Inspection Frequency
 - Special Inspection Date
 - Special Inspection Frequency
 - Underwater Inspection Date
 - Underwater Inspection Frequency
 - Posted Load Rating/Restrictions
 - Load Rating Date
 - Scour Evaluation
 - Scour Critical Plan of Action

- All Scorecards have been updated to easily identify Performance Measure data elements.
 - The data selection criteria has been added to the Planning and Adjustment sheets on the DOE Owned Data Validation Reporting form.

 - The Source Documentation Worksheet has been updated with a slightly different layout to make this document easier to use.
 - The Inbrief/Outbrief PowerPoint template as well as the Corrective Action Plan template has been updated to align with the FY23 validation guidance.
