Subject: Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) Version 4.1 Release

Today, Wednesday, September 20, 2023, version 4.1 of the Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) was released. This release addresses the enhancements listed below.

FY23 Year-End Lockdown

- The following data fields have been locked down and will not be available for update until after the FY23 FIMS year-end snapshot is generated which is currently scheduled for October 30, 2023.

- The following functions have been disabled.
 - Upload process for the data elements listed in the table above
 - CAIS to FIMS Upload process
 - CAIS generated RPVs
 - Ability to create new assets in FIMS
 - AAIM transfer asset processing
- The following new Usage Codes have been added to FIMS
 - 646 Break – Building Usage Code that represents buildings where employees can meet, eat, rest, or prepare for the workday.
 - 1800 Subterranean Structure or Area (Unit of Measure = Each) – OSF Usage Code that represents underground human-made structure such as a mine or tunnel where work is performed beneath the surface of the earth and within an enclosed space.
