Today, Friday, April 10, 2026, version 5.2 of the Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) was released. This release includes the enhancements listed below.

### **New Data Element**

- A new data element called Estimated Excess Date has been added to the Status window for DOE Owned buildings, trailers and OSF's. This new data element is crucial for fulfilling statutory requirements, specifically 50 U.S.C. 2603, which mandates reporting on the Deactivation and Decommissioning (D&D) plans for nonoperational defense nuclear facilities as well as informing funding profiles for the Strategies and Funding Profile Report, and ECFWG. This information is currently captured in the Notes field for applicable assets that fall under the scope of this congressional report. The Excess Contaminated Facilities Working Group serves as the author of the Report to Congress. The Estimated Excess Date data element will significantly enhance these reports by providing a more precise timeline for when facilities are expected to become excess and require deactivation and decommissioning and budget requests. This improved data will drive better strategic planning and resource allocation for future D&D efforts, allowing for more accurate cost estimations and prioritization of higher-risk facilities. Populate this data element for all DOE Owned buildings, trailers and OSF's that are part of this report.
