Today, Wednesday, September 27, 2017, version 3.1 of the Facilities Information Management System (FIMS) was released. This release addresses the enhancements listed below.

FY17 YEAR-END LOCKDOWN

- The following data fields have been locked down and will not be available for update until after the FY17 year-end snapshot is generated on November 6, 2017.

- The following functions have been disabled.
 - Upload process for the data elements listed in the table above
 - CAIS to FIMS Upload process
 - Archive capability for all Property Types
 - Ability to create new assets in FIMS

FRPP POPULATION QUERIES

- Query FRPP 01 has been modified to include Year Built for DOE Owned buildings, trailers and OSF's.
- Developed a new query, FRPP 10, which includes Total No of Federal Employees, Total No of Contractor Employees and Total No of Other Personnel.
- Query FRPP 07 has been modified to include Effective Date for DOE Leased buildings, trailers, OSF and land.

FIMS POPULATION QUERIES

- Query FIMS 11 has been modified to include Space Type Usable SF – Office for buildings and trailers (all Ownerships).

- The picklist for Can't Currently Be Disposed on the Status window now includes the following new option.
